Each year, American Farmers & Ranchers captures the creativity of students across the state of Oklahoma with our annual poster contest. There's always a remarkable response and each year the home office receives over 13,000 posters. This year's theme is **"Farm to Fork."**

Guidelines for the contest are as follows:

- Posters must solely be the work of the student. Students may use crayons, markers, pens, pencils, etc.
- Posters will be judged on originality, creativity, neatness, content and overall effect.
- There will be two age divisions:
 - **Division I: Grades 1 and 2**
 - **Division II: Grades 3 and 4**
- Cash will be awarded to students as follows in each division:
 - **First Place: \$100**
 - **Second Place: \$75**
 - **Third, Fourth & Fifth Place: \$50.**
- Top winners will be recognized at the Annual AFR State Convention in Norman at the Embassy Suites on February 11-13, 2022.
